It reveals the joys and sorrows, the conflicts, the paradoxes, and the different challenges facing women's bonding. The book reveals women's attempt to form bonds to fight back the impact of patriarchal structures that keep them oppressed. This aspect of women's lives is apparent in both Toni Morrison's novels: *Sula* and *Love*, Mariama Ba's *So Long a Letter*, and Sefi Atta's *Everything Good Will Come*. Despite the different geographical settings, all these novels link the failure of female friendship to patriarchal institutions that interfere with women's relationships and break them down. The book shows the healing power of female friendship that helps women recover from the destructive force of patriarchy. Female bonding helps these female characters face racial prejudice, polygamy, war, political instability, and the constraints of tradition. 164 pp. Englisch.
